What is Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the season in the church year known as Lent. I invite you, therefore, in the name of Christ, to observe a holy Lent by self-examination and penitence, by prayer and fasting, by works of love, and by reading and meditating on the Word of God, in beginning with this service today.
